Dyslexia Program

- During the 2020-2021 school year, Salem Public School District used the
 evidenced-based Phonics First Program in small group intervention to
 address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics
 of dyslexia.
- 50 students received literacy interventions.
- During the 2020-2021 school year, 23 students attending Salem Public School District received dyslexia intervention services three times per week from a trained dyslexia interventionist.
- 10 students were identified during the 2020-2021 school year, 10 students attending Salem Public School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. 1 student completed the program. 14 students were tested and 4 did not qualify.
- The district will be using Phonics First during the 2021-2022 school year.
