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SALEM SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES SALEM SCHOOL DISTRICT December 19, 2022

The Board of Education of the Salem School District #30, State of Arkansas, met in regular session Monday, December 19, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Boardroom on the high school campus. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Coffman.

The Chairman declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for business.

The minutes from the November 21, 2022 regular meeting were reviewed. Miller made the motion with a second by Hall to approve the minutes as written.

The Chairman called for discussion.

First on the agenda was student recognition from high school Principal Cody Curtis. Mr. Curtis had quite a lengthily list of recognitions. Congratulations to all.

Recommendation was made to accept the legal transfer of three students from the Highland School District to the Salem School District. Motion was made by Yarnell with a second by Hall to accept the transfers.

Superintendent Guiltner discussed with the board a classified policy interpretation, regarding extended pay for classified substitutes. Extended pay should include pay for any substitute licensed or classified excluding bus drivers.

These purchases will not exceed \$21,000.00 and will be purchased from the building fund. Motion was made by Miller with a second from Yarnell to make these purchases from the building fund.
