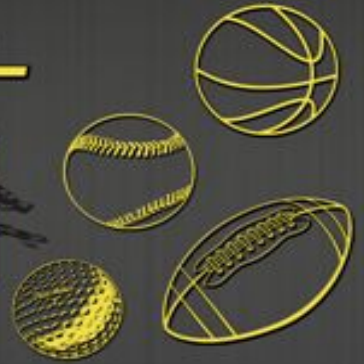

b. 8th Grade

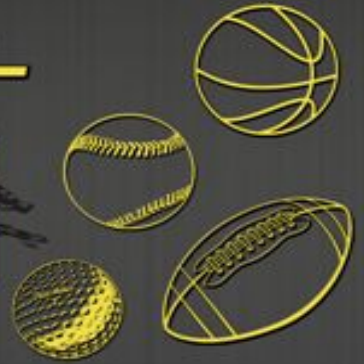
- i. English 88.89% Ready or Exceeding, State average 74.8%
